Re: CDC Cruise Industry Guidance

Dear Director Walensky:

As Mayor of Broward County, Florida, I have been a strong advocate for vaccinations, masks, and social distancing. When I promulgated regulations for Broward's reopening (before our orders were overridden by Governor DeSantis) I consulted with Dr. Fauci, the CDC, HHS, Johns Hopkins, etc. While I agree with the CDC's current Cruise Industry Guidance that 95% of passengers and 98% of crew members must be vaccinated and that masks should be worn, I strongly urge you to consider adding Norwegian Cruise Line's (NCL) COVID-19 proposed safety protocols as an alternative option for the cruise industry. NCL has proposed requiring that 100% of its passengers and crew be vaccinated, and that masks are not required to be worn. Candidly, I believe their proposal would both be safer for passengers and crew, and would provide a better cruising experience for the passengers.

I believe that adding NCL's protocols as an alternative option will be helpful to the industry and to the safety of passengers and crew members.

Thank you again for all that you and the CDC are doing for our country.
